

Every Wednesday, mentors from the Hy-Vee Information Technology Team meet with Urbandale High School HyperStream students, teachers, and administrators to provide guidance and facilitate learning about leading technology initiatives. The Urbandale HyperStream Club multimedia team recently developed the "J-Hawk Informer" which is an opt-in text messaging system for students and parents that alerts them to key updates regarding the UHS lunch menu, inclement weather, and school news. In doing so, students have learned how to assess the needs of fellow students, develop a program to support those needs, design specifications for a strong user interface, and deliver a project from concept to completion.
