



Urbandale Police Department's Safety City 2018



What is it? A week-long summer program for children entering kindergarten in the fall of 2018. They will learn about traffic safety, fire safety, home, playground and other kinds of personal safety in an entertaining, positive environment. To make learning about safety fun we incorporate songs, story books, films, games, and artwork in addition to riding Big Wheels in a mock city setting. We also provide the experience of riding on a school bus to the Urbandale Police and Fire departments for tours. Safety City is taught by Urbandale Police Officers and staff. They are assisted by a team of student helpers.

Who? Children who live in Urbandale and will attend kindergarten in the fall of 2018. This also includes students attending Urbandale non-public schools, and those in Urbandale homeschool programs.

When? There is a limit of 35 students per session. Enrollment will be on a first come, first serve basis. Choose one session that fits your needs:
